

Objectives

On behalf of the European Society of Pathology Working Group (ESUP), the Genitourinary Pathological Course will focus on the most updated scientific findings in the field of the diagnosis and treatment of genitourinary tumors. The Course will reunite pathologists from Europe and United States, and offer the opportunity to define the pathological criteria for a correct diagnosis of common and rare genitourinary tumors, highlighting the modern molecular biology approach. The Course will be held in the National Cancer Institute in Milan opening the doors to the warm and brilliant atmosphere of the upcoming Expo 2015.
